### **Fatal Automobile vs. Pedestrian Collision**

On December 17, 2014, at 8:07 pm Pleasanton Police Officers responded to Stoneridge Drive near Guzman Parkway on a reported automobile vs. pedestrian collision. Upon arrival, officers discovered all involved parties were on scene. The pedestrian was being provided first aid by an off-duty police officer who was not involved in the collision. Despite lifesaving efforts by EMS and law enforcement personnel, the subject died at the scene.

Initial statements and evidence indicate the driver of the vehicle was traveling eastbound Stoneridge Drive at the speed limit when the male subject darted from the roadside, into the traffic lane, directly in front of the vehicle.

Alcohol was not a factor and while it was raining heavily at the time, weather does not appear to have been a contributing factor.

All involved parties are cooperating with the investigation and their identities are not being released at this time.

Stoneridge Drive was closed for approximately three hours and reopened at 11:30 pm. The investigation is continuing and anyone with information that might be associated with this incident is asked to call the Pleasanton Police Department at 925-931-5100.
