UPDATE

Pleasanton Police Officers and members from Alameda County Sheriff's Department's Bomb Team, aided by a bomb sniffing K-9, have completed a search of the Amador Valley High School Campus; the search revealed no explosives of any kind. School officials have re-opened the school campus for both staff and students however they will not be holding class today. According to school officials, all other Pleasanton Schools are open today and Amador Valley High School will resume normal class schedule on Monday.

Detectives will continue to investigate the threat to determine who was responsible for sending the email. Anyone with information about this threat is encouraged to call Pleasanton Police at 931-5100.

Bomb Threat at High School

The principal at Amador Valley High School received an email shortly before 7 am this morning containing a bomb threat on campus. Pleasanton police officers partnered with school staff to evacuate the school campus. A search of the campus will be conducted with the aid of the Alameda County Sheriff's Department's Bomb Team and dog.

Pleasanton Police Detectives are working to determine the location from where the email was sent.
