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Enrollment Open for 2017 Citizens' Police Academy

Pleasanton, Calif. – The Pleasanton Police Department is proud to announce enrollment is now open for our 25th Citizens' Academy which will be held between Thursday, January 19, 2017 and April 27, 2017.

The goals of the Citizens' Academy are to create closer partnerships with the community through education and exposure to law enforcement procedures, and to discuss the importance of relationships and community engagement has in policing.

All sessions of the Academy will be held on Thursday evenings from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. at the Pleasanton Police Department. These classes are primarily taught by Department personnel and cover a wide variety of topics including Community Policing, Patrol Procedures, Radio Communications, SWAT, Narcotics Investigations, Crime Prevention, Traffic Enforcement, K-9's, Evidence Collection, Use of Force Issues, Animal Services and the DARE program.

This program is open to adults only and enrollment is limited to those who live or work in the City of Pleasanton. They must be free of any felony convictions, have no misdemeanor arrests within one year of application, and successfully complete a background investigation.
